International Madison Classic

International Madison Classic Format and Rules:

Racing Format: The International Madison Classic will consist of 3 team style races, each accumulating points towards the International Madison Classic Omnium. Each team will start the final madison "chase" (points race) with the sum of their points from the previous events. Points scored from sprints and laps taken in the final chase will be added to the team's total. With the team with the most points being declared the International Madison Classic Champions.

International Madison Classic races: The events for the evening will be the following:

- Madison Scratch Race
- Team Elimination
- Madison Chase Final

Points Scoring: Each of the first 2 events will earn 10-6-5-4-3-2 points to the top six (6) placing teams. Sprints in the final madison chase will score 5-3-2-1 points to the top four (4) placing teams. With the exception of the final sprint, which will score 10-6-4-2 points to the top four (4) teams.

The Taking and Losing of Laps: No points will be awarded for laps taken in the scratch and elimination. Laps taken in these races will only count towards the placing of the specific event. However, laps taken on the field in the final madison chase will be awarded 20 points to the team's total for the evening, just as in the international omnium format. Teams that lose a lap on the field in the final chase will have 20 points deducted from their total for the evening. Teams losing 3 or more laps on the field may be withdrawn from the competition.

Explanation of Individual Races:

Madison Scratch Race: All teams will take to the track

together for the scratch race. At all times during the race one rider must be "racing" in the race and one rider must be on "relief". Laps taken and lost on the field will count only towards the result of the scratch race. No points will be awarded or deducted for the taking or losing of laps on the field. Final placing for the scratch race will be determined by the team(s) having covered the distance the fastest (laps up) and then by placing on the final sprint.

Team Elimination: There will be no exchanges by teammates during the elimination. Both members of each team will be actively "racing" in the elimination race at all times until pulled by the commissaire. There will be no riders riding on "relief" during the elimination. Each rider in the race will be pulled individually from the race as in a standard elimination until only 1 rider remains. Only the highest finishing rider from each team will determine the team's placing in the elimination. Should both members of a specific team finish higher (i.e. 3rd and 4th) than any member of another team (i.e. 5th), the second rider of the team shall be removed from the placing's and the first rider of the next team moved up the finish order (5th finisher earns 4th place points for their team).

Final Madison Chase: Each team will start the race with the sum of their points from the previous races (similar to the international omnium). During the chase, sprints will be every 10 laps with points being scored 5-3-2-1. The final sprint will be scored 10-6-4-2. Any ties on points will be determined by the "racing" team member's placing on the final sprint. Teams that gain/lose laps on the field will be awarded/deducted +/-20 points respectively to their totals. The team with the most points at the end of the final chase will be crowned International Madison Classic Champion. Any ties on points will be determined by the "racing" team member's placing on the final sprint.
